ANNOUNCEMENT

Usinas Siderúrgicas de Minas Gerais S/A - USIMINAS (Bovespa:USIM3, USIM5, USIM6; OTC: USNZY; Latibex: XUSI, XUSIO) informs that in order to adapt its production to the current steel market demand, it has decided to interrupt temporarily operations in Blast Furnace #1 at José Bonifácio de Andrada Mill, in Cubatão (SP), for approximately 90 days from March 9th 2009.

Pig iron production will be reduced by approximately 270 thousand tons, or around 6% of the Company's annual capacity. Such adjustment will allow Usiminas to reduce its costs, while preserving its strength during the current market scenario.
